

Clydesdale Hockey Club - 2020 Sports Camps - Terms and Conditions.

If your child, or anyone in your household has or is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you do not attend camp. We ask that if your child or anyone in your household show symptoms after camp begins that you make us aware of their symptoms and do not attend subsequent days. We ask that you follow all government guidelines with regards to social distancing when in and around the club grounds. Please follow Government guidelines with regards to COVID-19, which are attached at the end of this document.

- 30 children per half pitch
- 1 coach per ten children
- 64 on the pitch
- 30 on Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)/Grass (MUGA availability dependent, if not available we will use the grass)

Cost - £70.00 for 5 half days, £15.00 per half day.

Two sessions per day as follows:

Primary session - Ages 4-11, 10:00-12:00

Secondary session - Ages 12-17, 13:00-15:00.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, unfortunately we cannot offer early drop off or late pickup. We ask that you collect your child promptly upon their session finishing. We will review this in future and hope to offer our pre and post care for camps in future.

Due to Government/Sport Scotland/Scottish Hockey guidelines, we are restricted to 90 children per age group slot per day. We have decided to divide the day up to ensure appropriate coach to child ratio and allow more people to access the camp. As a result, we require advanced booking. We cannot accept any drop ins on the day, and your child will not have a place reserved until payment is confirmed by the club. Due to COVID-19, we ask that you pay by bank transfer. We will not be accepting cash or cheque payments for this camp. Please note, refunds cannot be offered for cancellations within 48 hours of camp starting (10:00am on the Saturday prior). We also cannot offer a camp swap once booking has been confirmed.

We are restricted to 90 players per session per day. If the first 90 sign-ups are for the full week, we cannot offer any day bookings. Please put your child's name & camp number as the reference for our records. E.g. Amy Robertson, Camp 1 & 2. We hope to be able to offer cash and cheque payments in future, and will review this for 2021. We ask that you bring only what you need to play and provide all of your own equipment. The club will not be able to provide shoes, gloves, shin guards, or mouth guards. The same also goes for things such as sunscreen. Water taps will also not be accessible, so we encourage to bring enough water to last the two hours. Please arrive prepared to play hockey.

For those who do not own their own stick, we can offer the use of one that will be disinfected the weekend prior to camp starting. We ask that you keep it for the duration of the camp and return it when you finish your time with us at camp. We will then disinfect the stick to ensure we meet cleaning regulations. We will provide balls, cones and other non-personal hockey equipment required which will be disinfected twice a day. The venue will be appropriately cleaned before each session. We also ask that everyone brings both waterproofs and a change of clothing. In case of emergency facilities will be made available for the changing of clothes, but in general, access to the clubhouse will be restricted to upstairs toilets only.

Entry to and exit from the club ground will be restricted to the side gate at the main door of the clubhouse. When arriving we ask that you arrive within fifteen minutes of the start of camp and that you observe social distancing, allowing 2 metres of space for others entering/exiting the grounds. We cannot allow any spectators at the field and we ask that you leave the ground when you drop your child at camp.

Upon collection we ask that you wait on the grass at the clubhouse for your child. We will keep the children in their groups and proceed to leave in these groups. This is to minimise the amount of people entering/exiting the grounds at the one time. We request that you collect your child on the grass as you enter the ground. We ask that you kindly make use of the hand sanitisation gel provided at the gate when entering/exiting the ground. These are also provided at various points around the ground/pitch and we will be encouraging the use of it for our campers (allergies etc permitting).

We hope that the unfamiliar restrictions we have had to place around the camp are only temporary and that we can revert to our usual camp experience in the future, or whenever COVID-19 restrictions are loosened. Our camp will take place at Clydesdale Cricket and Hockey Club, Titwood, 22 Beaton Road, Glasgow, G41 4LB. Pictures and videos may be taken for promotion, marketing and publicity purposes. By attending the camp, you grant permission to allow pictures and videos to be taken and used for these purposes, you can opt out of this on your registration form. The club has a Child Protection policy and the camp will be administered in line with this policy. By attending the camp, you grant permission for First Aid to be administered to your child. You also authorise the club representative to allow medical professionals to treat the child if required. We will always try to contact the main/emergency contact immediately if such circumstances arise.

By booking your child in to our summer camp(s) you agree that your household is free of COVID-19 and any symptoms that come with it. You also agree to having read, understood and consented to the above terms and conditions.
