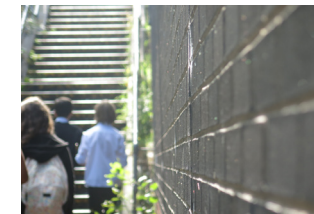
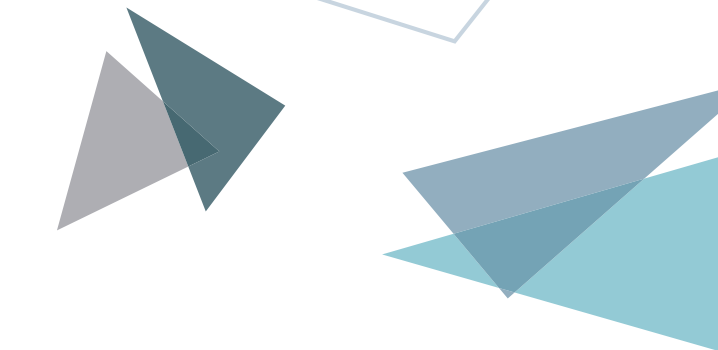
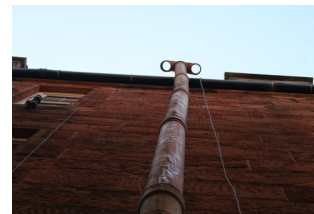
SCOTTISH CIVIC TRUST MY PLACE PHOTOGRAPHY
