Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we cannot offer early drop off or late pickup. We ask that you collect your child promptly.

Due to guidelines we require advanced booking. We cannot accept any drop ins on the day, and your child will not have a place reserved until payment is confirmed by the club.

Our preferred method of payment is by bank transfer, however we do accept cash & cheque.

If paying by cash, we cannot provide change so please pay in exact amount in a sealed envelop with your child's details on the front when you arrive.

Please note, refunds cannot be offered for cancellations within 48 hours of camp starting (10:00am on the Saturday prior).

Kit.

We ask that you bring only what you need to play and provide all of your own equipment.

Kit list.

Required

Stick, Sport shoes, Mouth guard, Shin guards, Water, Appropriate clothing.

Optional.

Glove,

Avoid.

Branded school uniform, Studded footwear.

We can provide a stick for those who require one.

We cannot provide shoes, gloves, shin guards, or mouth guards.

The same also goes for things such as sunscreen.

We will provide balls, cones and other non-personal hockey equipment required.

We also ask that everyone brings both waterproofs and a change of clothing. In case of emergency facilities will be made available for the changing of clothes, but in general, access to the clubhouse will be restricted to upstairs toilets only. Entry & exit from the club ground will be restricted to the side gate of the clubhouse.
